

The University of Georgia College of Veterinary Medicine is seeking a Veterinary Microbiologist for its Tifton Veterinary Diagnostic and Investigational Laboratory (TVDIL), Tifton, Georgia.

Position is responsible for supervising microbiology diagnostic services (serology, virology and molecular diagnostics) at the TVDIL. This position is available at the faculty rank of either Public Service Assistant, Assistant Professor, or Associate Professor. MS degree in microbiology and 2 years of experience in veterinary diagnostic serology, virology and/or molecular diagnostics required for faculty rank of Public Service Assistant. DVM, DVM/PhD, or PhD and 2 years of experience in veterinary diagnostic serology, virology and/or molecular diagnostics required for faculty rank of Assistant Professor. DVM, DVM/PhD, or PhD and 5 years of experience in veterinary diagnostic serology, virology and/or molecular diagnostics required for faculty rank of Associate Professor.

Preferred candidates will have competency in clinical laboratory diagnostics of infectious diseases and will be board eligible or boarded in one or more of the veterinary microbiology subspecialties by the American College of Veterinary Microbiologists. Candidates should also have knowledge of microbial pathogenesis, and have a background in working with Laboratory Information Management and Quality Management Systems. Excellent written and oral communication skills and knowledge of MS Office products are preferred. Supervisory and leadership skills; people skills; the ability to work independently and as a team player and as a team leader on collaborative projects are desired.
