TEMPORARY FULL-TIME POSITION (5-YEAR REPLACEMENT)

Responsibilities

Perform various teaching duties (up to a maximum of 90% of the workload), including:

- Participate in clinical teaching while responding to the needs of users of the veterinary microbiology lab;
- Supervise students enrolled in internship programs;
- Participate in the teaching of students in the veterinary school's PhD program;
- Evaluate students' learning;
- Provide academic guidance and assistance to students;
- Collaborate in the training of students enrolled in the residency program in Veterinary Laboratory Diagnostics, as part of the Diploma of Specialized Studies (D.E.S.), a professional degree leading to certification by the American College of Veterinary Microbiologists (ACVM);
- See to the application of the biosecurity program in the Centre Hospitalier Universitaire Vétérinaire (CHUV), the Diagnostics Service (SD), the teaching colonies and the research labs of the Faculty of Veterinary Medicine.

The candidate will also be required to perform duties related to research and/or the development and/or the functioning of the institution (a minimum of 10% of the workload), including, mainly:

- Development of a biosecurity program in accordance with Canadian biosecurity standards in the CHUV, the SD, the teaching colonies and the research labs of the Faculty of Veterinary Medicine.

Requirements

- Doctor of veterinary medicine (DVM) degree or the equivalent;
- Certification by the American College of Veterinary Microbiologists (ACVM) or eligibility and attainment of ACVM certification within two (2) years of being hired;
- Training or experience in biosecurity and/or antimicrobial resistance surveillance is an asset;
- License to practice issued by the Ordre des médecins vétérinaires du Québec;
- Sufficient knowledge of French (written and spoken) or a commitment to learning French.

Additional information

The work schedule is flexible and includes activities on weekday evenings and weekends (based on a schedule established by the department).
